She is an Adjunct Professor of Information Law at the University of Toronto Law School.

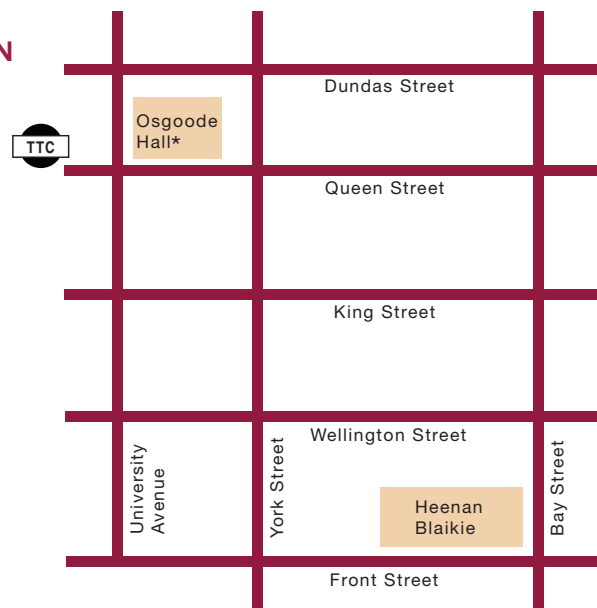
