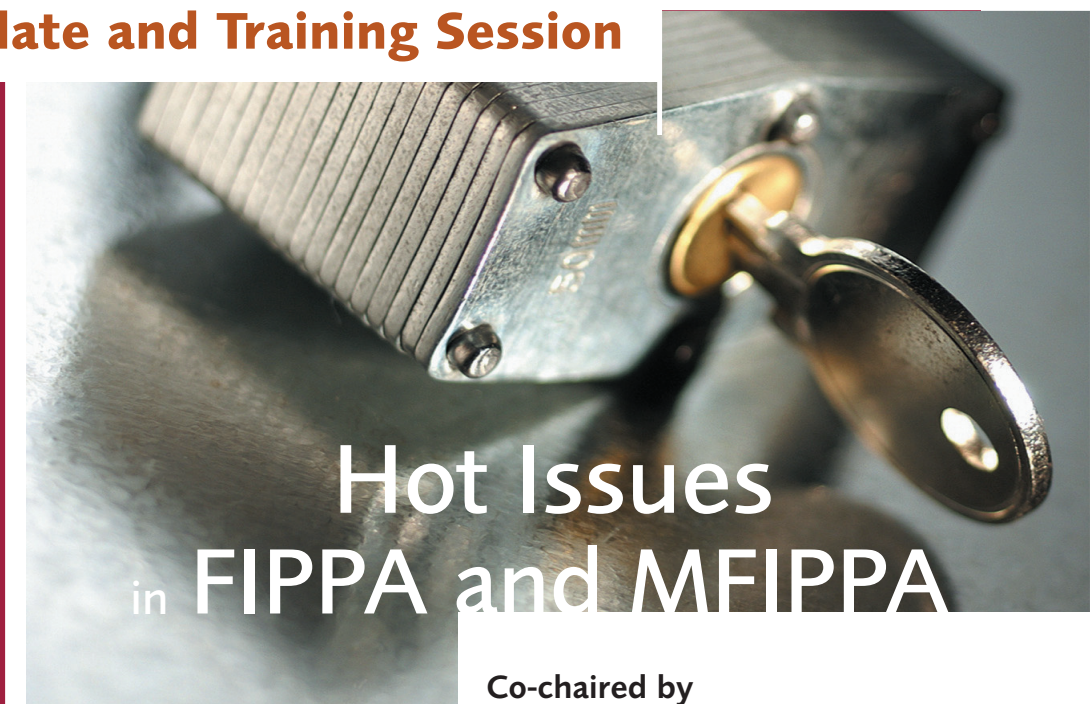

Priscilla received the first Karen Spector Award for Excellence in Privacy Law from the Ontario Bar Association in 2006, and the Attorney General of Ontario Awards for Professional Achievement in 1999 & for Innovation in 2004. She is an Adjunct Professor of Information Law at the University of Toronto Law School.



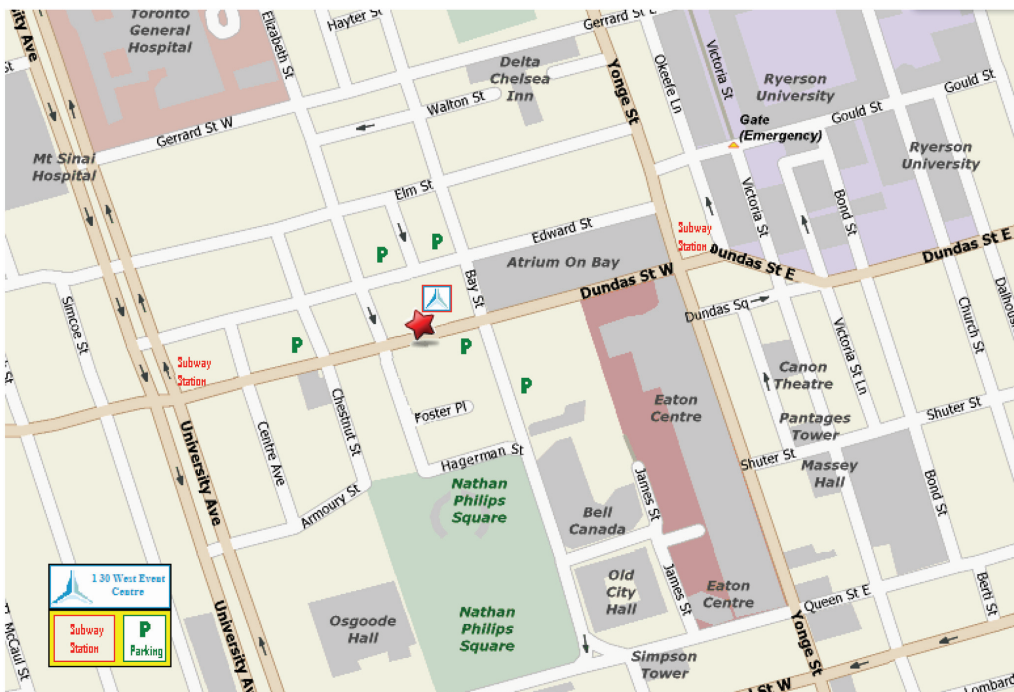
ADAM KARDASH
