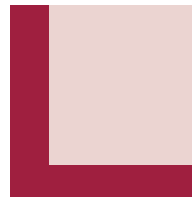

Priscilla Platt joined Heenan Blaikie as counsel in March 2006, bringing over 25 years of well recognized expertise in privacy, access to information and related legal issues both in the public and private sectors. Previously, Priscilla was Senior Counsel at the Ministry of the Attorney General where she provided advice to the Ontario Government on access and privacy law.

Priscilla's practice focuses almost exclusively on privacy and access to information law. Her clients include institutions covered by Ontario's *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FIPPA) and its municipal counterpart, MFIPPA, such as municipalities, universities, Crown agencies and others, as well as entities governed by the federal government's access to information and privacy legislation. An active member of several professional organizations, Priscilla was a founding member of the Privacy Law Sections of both the Canadian Bar Association and the Ontario Bar Association (OBA), and has served as Chair of both Sections. She is a member of the executive of the OBA's Privacy Law and Public Sector Lawyers Sections. She is co-author of Heenan Blaikie's electronic guide to FIPPA and MFIPPA, available at www.accessprivacy.ca.

On June 20, 2006, Priscilla was awarded the first **Karen Spector Award for Excellence in Privacy Law** by the Ontario Bar Association. The award was presented to Priscilla in recognition of her exceptional contributions and achievements in the practice of privacy law. Since 2007, Priscilla has been an adjunct professor of *Information Law* at the University of Toronto Law School.

Priscilla graduated from the University of Toronto Law School in 1975 and was called to the Bar in Ontario in 1977.



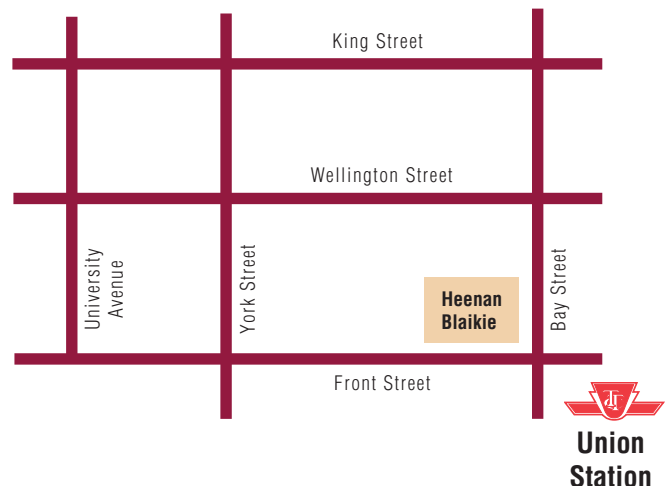
